Interesting History

The Cactus Café and Gallery, formerly the Sacred Heart Infants' School, was opened on Saturday, 3rd October, 1998 by Senor Raphael Steger, Ambassador of Mexico.

The site of the building, Lot 10, Warne Street, Wellington, was purchased by John Andrew Gardiner, Squatter on 30-9-1865 for fifteen pounds.

In the 1880's the land was purchased by the Presbyterian Church and a small church was built in 1883. This church was deemed too small and the land and building were sold in 1907 to Thomas Hugh Cameron, merchant, where he conducted a business after alterations on the church.

On the 2nd May 1929, Mr Cameron sold the property to John Francis Norton, Bishop of the Catholic Church at Barhurst, and the present building was erected.

The building was designed by Sydney architects, in Spanish Mission style, which was very popular in Australia between the First and Second World Wars. This style suited the Australian climate beautifully, and this building with it's high ceilings, north facing verandah, lots of windows on the south and east and none on the west, optimises the suns movements and local climate perfectly.

The property was purchased in 1998 and after a facelift began it's new life as the Cactus Café and Gallery.
